



G20 GERMANY 2017 BUSINESS 20 DIALOGUE



B20 Summit, Berlin, 2-3d May 2017

One of the exciting highlights for the year 2016 was Boniswa's participation in the **WTO Trade Dialogue** where over 60 business leaders came to address the challenges of a private sector. Emanating from the Trade Dialogue, a new opportunity was presented to Boniswa; **Lynette Magasa** was invited to share her business ideas on inclusive trade rules for SMEs during the WTO Public Forum in Genève. Magasa has also accepted an invitation from B20 to become Co-Chair of the B20 SMEs Cross-thematic Group.

On May 3rd, 2017, the B20 has officially handed over its Policy Recommendations to German Chancellor **Angela Merkel** in Berlin.

The recommendations are the product of a yearlong process of B20 seven Taskforces and Cross-thematic Groups, which comprise over 700 members from all G20 economies. Developed under the theme "Building Resilience – Improving Sustainability – Assuming Responsibility", the B20 Policy Recommendations span the entire scope of the G20 process: from the need to maintain an open, rule-based trading system, to facilitating sustainable finance and increased efforts to widen the inclusiveness and resilience of the labor market in the face of technological change.
